

AIFS-HACU Scholarship Program *for London Internship students*

Purpose

The purpose of the program is to provide up to \$150,000 in scholarships for outstanding Hispanic students to study abroad on a London Internship program.

Program

Scholarship winners will study for a summer (12 weeks) or semester (Fall or Spring) at Richmond, The American International University in London. The program consists of intensive study of contemporary British Culture, Internship Seminars and an unpaid internship in a wide range of private companies and public organizations.

Fields of internships include Advertising, Art & Design, Broadcast Film and Production, Finance and Accounting, Legal, IT, Journalism, Marketing, Music, PR. Non-profit NGO & Politics and Government.

About Richmond

Like the city in which it is located, Richmond, The American International University in London, provides a diverse, multicultural environment. The University offers small classes in a wide variety of disciplines taught by faculty from leading British and American institutions in fully accredited BA and BS programs. During the academic year, students come to Richmond from more than 100 different countries, although the summer school is predominantly American. Small classes and personal attention from the faculty, an extensive extracurricular program and a wide range of courses make Richmond an ideal summer study choice.

Richmond is an independent, co-educational, non-profit international liberal arts and professional studies University founded in 1972. The University is accredited by the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, one of the six regional accrediting bodies recognized by the U.S. Department of Education licensed by the Department of Education in the State of Delaware and are also validated by the Open University.

Awards/Eligibility

Awards/Eligibility: Students will receive scholarships of up to 50% of the full program fee. Students must meet all standard Richmond/AIFS eligibility requirements.

Awards will be made by AIFS in conjunction with its Advisory Board.
