Students are advised to work with their home institution’s study abroad coordinator and their academic advisor to facilitate the transfer of academic credit.

Applicants must submit a completed AIFS academic year and semester application (with the \$95 non-refundable application fee), the scholarship application and essay.

Completed scholarship and program applications must be postmarked by April 15 for Fall Quarter/Fall Semester or October 1 for Spring Semester
